| 1.  | <b>LONG VOWELS</b><br>( ا و ي )                      | What are 3 long vowel letters? How are they written and pronounced<br>a. long vowel letters with short vowels on them<br>b. long vowel letters with sukoon on them<br>c. long vowel letters next to each other<br>d. Difficult Words | <b>12 – 24</b><br>a. N/A<br>b. 27<br>c. N/A<br>d. N/A |
| 2.  | <b>TANWEEN</b>                                       | What is tanween and how it is written in 3 ways. How is it read?<br>- Exception about ha & hamzah  | <b>32</b>   |
| 3.  | <b>WOW LEEN AND YA LEEN</b>                          | Having a sukoon on و or ي AND having a fathah on previous letter creates the swinging sound in Arabic such as Cycle, Layla, Time, Mound,<br>- Shaddah with wow leen & yah leen   | <b>28</b>   |
| 4.  | <b>SHORT FORM OF LONG VOWEL LETTERS</b>              | Long vowels letter ( ا و ي ) can be written as Tashkeelaat (symbols)   | <b>38</b>   |
| 5.  | <b>MADDAH &amp; MUQATI'AAT</b>                       | These two tashkeel elongate the long vowel letter. In Muqati'aat words, these tashkeel requires to make each individual letter be elongated  | <b>50 &amp; 53</b>                                    |
| 6.  | <b>LETTER WITH SUKOON BEFORE LETTER WITH SHADDAH</b> | Normally called the <u>Unnamed Rule</u> , the reader should omit the letter with sukoon if immediate next letter has a shaddah on it<br>- Its application as “Sun” & “Moon” letters  | <b>55</b>   |
| 7.  | <b>HAMZA TUL WASL</b>                                | Alif with this special symbol connects the letter before it and after it but Alif itself is omitted in reading   | 83 of white book                                      |
| 8.  | <b>SMALL LETTERS</b>                                 | Simple reading rule for “little” letters shown on words in Quran<br>a) LITTLE MEEM م BEFORE BA ب<br>b) NOON QUTNI ن<br>c) LITTLE SEEN س ALLOWED TO BE READ AS SUAD ص   | a. 58<br>b. 59<br>c. 62                               |
| 9.  | <b>TA MARBOOTAH ة</b>                                | It is read as letter ه if we stop at the word.<br>It is read (and opened as letter ت in writing) if the reader does not stop at the word   | <b>61</b>   |
| 10. | <b>RAMOOZ AUQAAF</b>                                 | Punctuation in Quran verses (first lesson in Arabic 3)   | N/A   |
